Important Information to Consider Before Applying

Tuition: (\$2500)

A \$300 non-refundable registration deposit is required within 5 days of acceptance. The remaining tuition (\$2200) is due BEFORE arriving in Mozambique. If you are interested in participating in the optional extended outreach, half of the tuition is due before arrival, and the remaining half is due on September 1st (a total cost of \$850).

Major expenses to consider:

- **Flights:**

Depending on your departure city, flights can start at around \$1600 to \$1800 USD for a round-trip fare. (Flights must fly into Beira Mozambique Airport code BEW as final destination.)

- **Visas:**

Mozambique can be finicky about visas. To participate in the School, you must obtain a visa before arrival through the E-visa portal (regardless of what is found on the internet about other avenues or services). Due to the way Mozambique does their visas, they can range from \$315-\$475 USD. This will be paid to immigration upon arrival and more details will be given once accepted.

- **Travel/Health Insurance:**

This is mandatory, and proof must be sent before arrival. (The Insurance must also cover helicopter flights and evacuation out of the country in case of emergency.)

Other Financial Info

Phone/Internet:

If you have an unlocked smartphone (not AT&T or Sprint), you should be able to easily buy a SIM card here and use the local service. Depending on the plan, this costs roughly \$10-\$15 USD. If you do not have an unlocked phone, you can speak to your current phone carrier to see if they will unlock it. It is quite necessary to have a phone for communication and logistic purposes while here. (Keep in mind there is no WIFI available for students on the base.)

Travel during the School

Transport:

Your tuition covers all local ground transportation during school activities but does not include personal travel.

Food:

Tuition covers basic local meals prepared in the kitchen daily and during outreach. These meals are very simple local dishes that consist of rice, beans, fish, greens, and sometimes chicken. There are some small grocery stores within walking distance that offer some other items but are limited. In Dondo, there are some restaurants as well where you can get pizza, beef, and other types of traditional food. Meals are relatively cheap depending on what you order (\$7-\$15 USD). These meals and extras are not covered by tuition.

Accommodation:

At the School, your tuition covers your lodging. During outreach and Crusade week (also extended outreach), students will be using tents at a local house in the city where we will evangelize. Depending on availability, renting a hotel room during the crusade (+/-5 nights) may be possible. Mozambique Hotels are basic and can range from \$35 to \$50 per night. This expense is not covered by tuition.

Health

Immunizations

Mozambique does not require visitors to have specific immunizations before travel. However, if you are traveling from a country known to have yellow fever, it is recommended that you bring proof of yellow fever vaccination to prevent hassle.

Illness:

Mozambique has access to most medicines if you happen to fall ill while at school. You will be given a list of recommended health items to bring with you.
